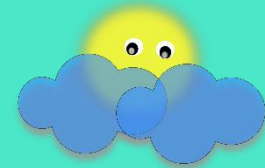

Physical Development

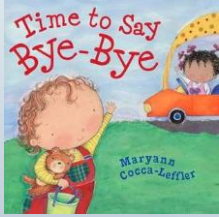

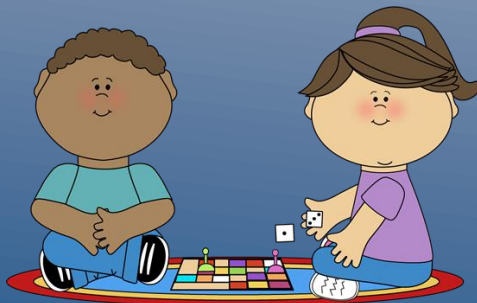

Communication and Language

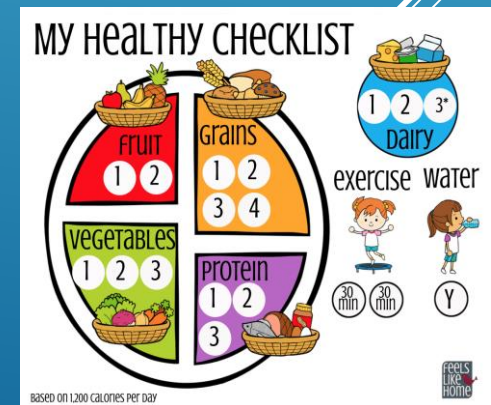
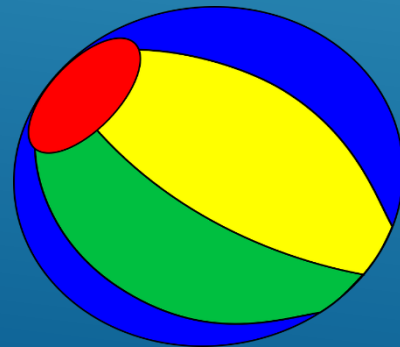


- I can understand some instructions.

- I can learn to use the toilet with help, and then independently.



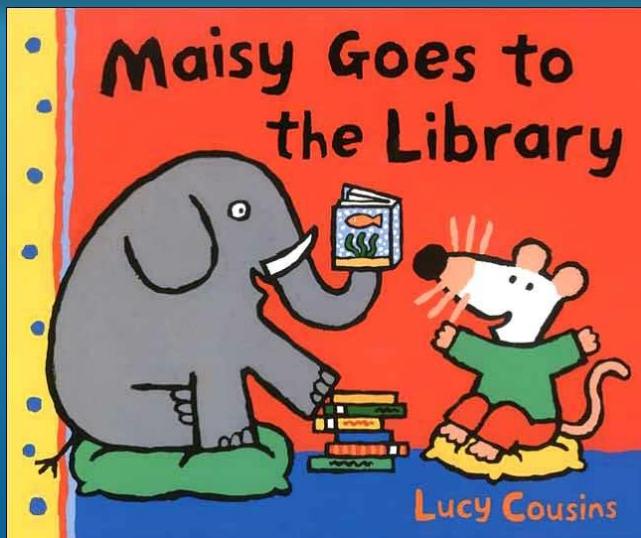
Specific Areas

I can build with a range of resources.

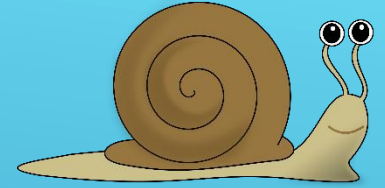
I can complete inset puzzles.

I can count in everyday context sometimes skipping numbers 1-2-3...-5.

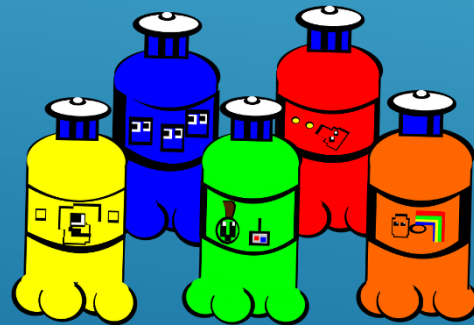
I can count when I am singing number songs.
