Tilehurst has shops, schools, offices, parks, houses and flats.

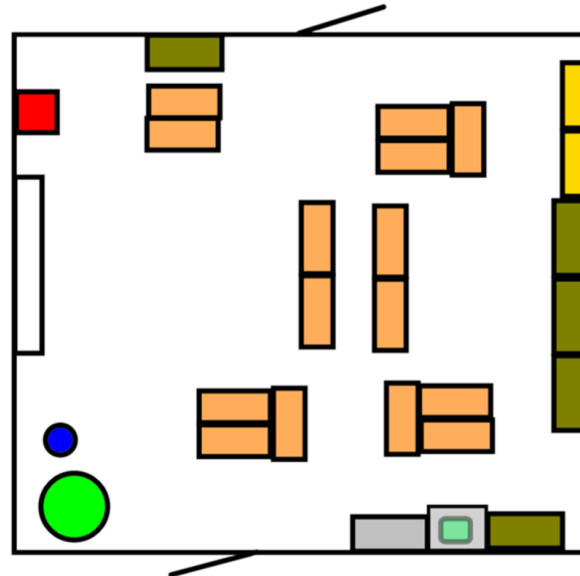


## Human & Physical Geography

| <b>Geography</b>         | Geography is the study of the world all around us and why it is like it is.                     |
| <b>Fieldwork</b>         | Going out to a real place to see what is there.                                                 |

| <b>Bird's eye view</b>   | The view when we are looking down from above.                                                   |
